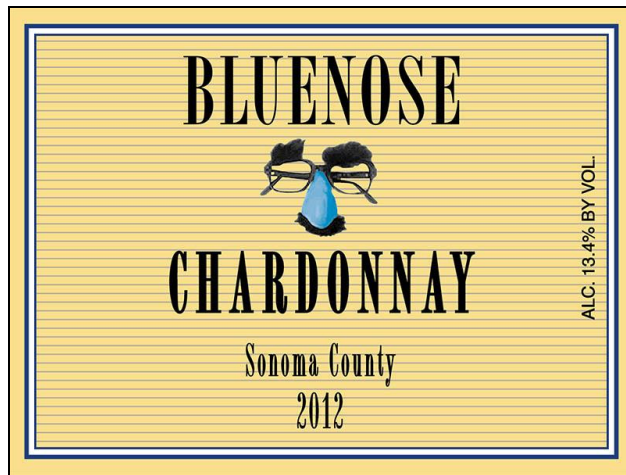


Bluenose Wines

2012 Sonoma County Chardonnay

Sourced from grapes grown in Healdsburg's Dry Creek Valley, this wine was primarily cold-tank fermented to express the intense fruit from the mature vineyard.
